- 1) Entrance fee £1 per race (to be paid before the 10-minute gun). All prizes sweepstake.
- 2) All races to be sailed under CHSC Sailing Instructions or as the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-28 (for River Cruisers 2-minute penalty applies). The start procedure will be a 10, 5, Start.
- 3) Handicaps - Portsmouth Numbers as declared in The Green Book with no adjustment for non-spinnaker use.
- 4) Where points for Challenge Trophies are concerned, ONE discard will be allowed (unless there are only two or less races).
- 5) River Cruisers - these will be downriver races for the Merlin Challenge Cup.
- 6) Separate class races may be organised if 5 or more boats enter, at the discretion of the OOD.
- 7) Split starts will be granted if the number of entries and the weather conditions merit such consideration.
- 8) All boats must have adequate insurance against third party liability (minimum cover £2,000,000).

BUOYANCY AIDS The wearing of adequate personal buoyancy by all dinghy sailors is compulsory (a wetsuit does not constitute adequate buoyancy), and keelboats and cruisers must carry an adequate number of buoyancy aids compatible with the number of crew on board and worn if Y flag is flown.

Oulton Week is run entirely by unpaid volunteers – so please use the forms provided to enter in advance.

- Fast Handicap is for dinghies with PY of 1162 or less. In addition, K1 and Flying Fifteen keelboats are permitted to compete in Fast Handicap races.
- Slow Handicap is for dinghies with PY of 1163 to 1665.
- The Race Committee may invite certain slow handicap boats to race in Fast Handicap series.
- The Laser/ILCA class race in the mornings is for standard rig (ILCA 7), radial rig (ILCA 6) and 4.7 rig (ILCA 4) boats. Handicaps will apply. They can change to smaller rigs but will be scored with the handicap that applies to the rig they entered with. They cannot change to larger rigs. At other times of the day, standard and radial rigs will sail in Fast Handicap races and lasers with 4.7 (ILCA 4) rigs will sail in Slow Handicap races.
- Optimists have their own class races in the mornings.
- Norfolk Dinghies will sail in Slow Handicap races. The first Norfolk in the afternoon Slow Handicap series will be awarded the Tideway Tankard.
- Hansa 303 Dinghies will race on Monday, Wednesday and Friday only.
- Mixed One Designs is restricted to WOD, BOD, Y&BOD and Squibs.
- River Cruiser split start will be decided by the class. *Please note:* the Fast and Slow fleets will sail in separate races but both will count toward the final results.
- Blackburn Trophy: Four-a-side Keelboat Team Race between WOD, BOD, Y&BOD and Squibs. Helms must have competed in a class race during Oulton Week 2026 of the class they are chosen to represent.
- The Bloodbath Race on Friday afternoon is an Allcomers 'average lap' handicap race.
