It is made up of a small pool of RYA Trained Officers and Volunteers with two dedicated Beat managers Pc Amy Barrell and Pc Paul Bassham led by Sgt Toby Gosden and overseen by the Operational Partnership Team Inspector. We have two patrol boats, based at Hoveton Police station.

Broads Beat celebrated its 28th anniversary last year and is officially the UK's longest running Police and Public Sponsorship Scheme (source - *Natural England*).

Our intentions remain to undertake a multi-agency approach to all aspects of community based Policing including the following core responsibilities:
